



HERMANN VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK BRICK FUNDRAISER



Phase I of Hermann's Veterans Memorial in the Market Street Park is a black granite monument bearing the names of the men and women of the City of Hermann in World War II, the same names that appeared on the original monument erected by the Hermann chapter of the American War Mothers in 1944.

Phase II of Hermann's Veterans Memorial includes:

--a black granite marker facing south, naming the entire Market Street park "Hermann Veterans Memorial Park", to be placed at the south end of the park and with the Pledge of Allegiance on the north side of the marker;

--to the north of the marker, a plaza area to be paved with commemorative brick pavers;

--a flagpole in the center of the plaza with black granite encircling the pole at its base and bearing the six service insignias;

--a bronze statue remembering and honoring a fallen soldier;

--a low retaining wall at the north end of the plaza where visitors may sit to honor and remember and with a dedicatory piece embedded in the wall;

--appropriate low-maintenance landscaping.

**You are invited to help make Phase II a reality and to complete the
Hermann Veterans Memorial Park.**

Sales of commemorative bricks will be a significant means of fundraising for the memorial project. The 4" x 8" honor/memorial bricks are being offered for \$125.

Recognition on the bricks is limited to those who have served in the United States military and have been discharged honorably or who are currently serving – during times of war or times of peace, living or deceased, from near or far.

Proof of service is required. A photo copy of one of the following will serve as proof: DD-214 (separation papers), newspaper article providing evidence of military service, county military record, military pension document, a photo in service uniform, or other clear evidence of military service.

More than one brick may be purchased. Simply duplicate the order form found on the reverse side of this sheet as needed or print the desired information on another sheet of paper.
