AN ORDINANCE TO CORRECT A TYPING ERROR IN ORDINANCE NUMBER 2294 REGARDING CURFEWS

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen passed Ordinance No 2294 regarding curfew rules; and

WHEREAS, Section Two of said ordinance erroneously referred to Code Section 215.1980. The reference should be to Section 215.1970.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HERMANN, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The text of Section Two of Ordinance No. 2294 is hereby revoked in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Section 215.1970, Subsection B, *Curfew for Juveniles* is hereby revoked in its entirety and a new subsection B is substituted in lieu thereof as follows:

B. *Curfew for Juveniles.*

1. It shall be unlawful for any person who is ~~fifteen (15) or sixteen (16)~~ sixteen (16) or seventeen (17) years of age to be or remain in or upon a public place within the City during the period ending at 5:00 A.M. and beginning:

- (1) At 11:59 P.M. on Friday and Saturday nights.
- (2) 11:00 P.M. on all other nights.

2. It shall be unlawful for any person who has not attained ~~fifteen (15)~~ sixteen (16) years of age to be or remain in or upon a public place within the City during the period ending at 5:00 A.M. and beginning at 10:00 P.M. This provision shall be in effect during all days of the week.

3. This Section does not apply if a Juvenile is:

- a. Accompanied by his/her parent;
- b. Attending or returning home in a direct route from a function at any school;
- c. Attending or returning home in a direct route from any officially sponsored activity;

- d. On an emergency errand at the request of his/her parent;
- e. Engaged in legitimate employment which requires his/her presence at his/her place of employment during the prohibited hours;
- f. On the sidewalk, street or alley directly adjacent to the building in which he/she resides.

SECTION TWO: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.

SECTION FOUR: The publisher of the City of Hermann ordinances shall be permitted to re-designate the section or sub-section number of this revised code section to fit within an appropriate portion of the Hermann City Code, within the discretion of the publisher.
