

INTRODUCED BY _____

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE SALARY FOR THE ELECTED OFFICE OF CITY COLLECTOR AND ESTABLISHING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HERMANN, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The salary for City Collector, most recently established by Ordinance 2261, is hereby adjusted. The City Collector shall receive an annual base salary of:

1. Fifty-Two Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Seven Dollars and 06/100 (\$52,137.06)
for the period beginning on the first day of the term of the above named officer after the next municipal election to be held on April 2, 2024, and ending on March 31, 2025; and
2. Fifty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-Three Dollars and 91/100 (\$54,743.91) for the period beginning on April 1, 2025, and continuing thereafter until subsequently amended by ordinance.

In addition to the foregoing base salary, if the Collector elects to participate in the City's Deferred Compensation Plan (the "Plan"), the City will match the Collector's contribution up to the maximum of five-percent (5%) of base compensation as provided above.

However, the total of all contributions to the Collector's Participation Account may not exceed the maximum amounts specified in Section 2.5 of the Plan.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final passage and approval.
